The University of Hartford will demonstrate its sub-scale, see-through power plant. This operating model accurately mimics a two loop Pressurized Water Reactor. This table top model can demonstrate start-up, normal operating and off-normal occurrences for PWRs. The glass components allow students to visually ascertain recirculating flow in U-tube steam generators, nucleate boiling and other fundamental PWR characteristics.
