“Transuranic Uptake at a Commercial Nuclear Power Station”

Please join us in welcoming **Michael D. Quinn**, of WorkPlace Cornerstone Associates (WCA), who will talk about an event at the Bruce Nuclear Power Station that resulted in several hundred worker exposures. Michael will discuss the precursors, the recovery effort, and the lessons learned from this high consequence/ high significance event.

Michael is a Principal of WCA, and has 39 years of experience in the commercial nuclear power industry. He started his career at CT Yankee Haddam Neck in 1975, earning a SRO License. Later he worked on the Station Recovery effort while Millstone was on the NRC watch list (1995-1999). Michael has consulted for the past 14 years to US and Canadian nuclear power stations, nuclear suppliers, and the US NRC, as well as with US DOE operations at Hanford, WIPP, Los Alamos, and Las Vegas.
